Film & Faith
An introduction to film studies.

Faith and Film will engage with the religious dimensions of six classic 20th and 21st century films that deal with religious ideas. Students will learn the basics of film analysis, as well as key aspects of the study of Christianity, religion, and art. Special emphasis of the class will be analyzing the ways that films shape our expectations and loves, how they form (and re-form), if we're not careful our characters.

C.S. Lewis on Tradition & Progress
The Abolition of Man & The Space Trilogy

This course studies C.S. Lewis's masterpiece of philosophy, The Abolition of Man, alongside his science fiction trilogy: Out of the Silent Planet, Perelandra, and That Hideous Strength. Students will consider themes such as the value of tradition, technology and its relationship to the natural world, and the reality of moral knowledge. In addition to Socratic discussion, students will write both nonfiction and fiction inspired by Lewis's ideas.
