She has been homeschooling and a part of our PSP community since 2016. Ashley assisted in the 3-Year-Old Preschool Class from 2018-2023. She has 2 children, ages 9 and 7, who love to attend Friday School!	The 3-Year-Old Preschool Class is designed to honor God while learning His divine attributes. The students learn hands on through imaginative play and fine/gross motor activities. The students are engaged in learning while being introduced to letters, writing, numbers, shapes, Bible stories, worship, dance, music, sharing, following directions, building friendships and much more! We look forward to an exciting year of adventure and growth for these little ones! Remember they must be potty trained!
Pre School 4's	Christina is a mother of 5 children with over 19 years of homeschooling experience. She has an AS in Early Child Development and will be completing her BS with her Site Supervisor Certification in 2023 at Cal Poly, Pomona. She has started and led countless ministries both at church and here at Legacy Christian. She has been teaching Preschool at Friday School since 2014. She also leads Impact, which was started in 2018 with the mission of building a stronger community for Jr. High students. Highlights from all the years serving are being part of the moment when a child accepts Christ, watching children grow up and being part of their lives into adulthood, building community, and helping women grow their gifts for Jesus. Connecting with theorists such as Piaget and Vygotsky, the four-year-old preschool class focuses on the processes of learning and not the product. Students are taught a curriculum that is developmentally appropriate, and the activities encompass not only what children are capable of doing on their own but what they can learn with the help of others. This class promotes cooperative play to learn problem-solving, independent reasoning, development of manners, and social skills. The class will focus on cognitive skills such as language and literacy, science, engineering, technology, math, art, and fine motor skills. This course will complement the learning taking place in the home by allowing students time to interact and learn from peers in an environment that is developmentally designed for them. Children must be potty trained.

3rd Grade	TBD	Our theme for the year is "World Changers!" We'll be learning about the lives of men and women of faith in history, the times they lived in, and the character qualities they lived out. We'll look at one person a week (Jackie Robinson, Bethany Hamilton, Fred Rogers, Harriet Tubman, and many others!) and learn about their lives through picture books, crafts, interactive assignments, games, music, practical skills, physical activities, and thought-provoking discussions. We'll also celebrate the seasons and holidays together.
